The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Thomas Graham has been appointed a constable in this County agreeable to an act of assembly ^{concurring} constables now if the said Thomas Graham shall well and truly discharge the duties of his said office of constable agreeable to the said act of assembly the above obligation to be void else remain in full force
