Sold & Delivered. By these presents do bargain sell & Deliver
unto the said Elizabeth S Lewis one bright bay horse eight
or nine years old last Spring near fourteen hands for half high
has a few gray hairs in her forehead also the off hind foot is
white a little but has no other perceptible brand to have. He has
the S^t Mare unto the S^t E S Lewis her exors & Executors & forever
of the said Tho^s Lewis for myself my heirs Executors &c. the S^t
Mare unto the S^t E S Lewis her heirs Executors &c. against all
persons do warrant & forever defend by these presents. In
