I JOHN DICKINSON all now by these presents that I William Dimmiedie of the County of Bath in the State of Virginia for divers good Causes and Considerations in Recennt^t moving have made, Ordained Constituted and Appointed John Dimmiedie of the County of Bath and State aforesaid my true and lawfull Attorney for me and in my name and for my use to sell and dispose of a certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred and fifty acres more or less lying and being in the County of Montgomery in the State of Kentucky on the waters of Licking Creek which said land I purchased of a certain William Balk of said State I do therefore hereby empower my said Attorney for me and in my name to make, and deliver, to the purchaser, or purchasers, of the aforesaid tract of land his or their legal representatives or assigns, a proper deed of conveyance, and should there be any disputes with respect to the right or title of the aforesaid land I do hereby empower my said attorney to transact with or settle, as he may be advised, or to defend any suit or suits that may be instituted for said land, hereby ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and touching the premises in as full and ample manner as if I myself had been personally present In witness whereof I the said William Dimmiedie have hereunto set my hand and seal
