 should she refuse to take him away then the said Negro Boy
 shall be given unto my son Absalom Hutchison clear of all Expenses
 to the sole use and behoof of her the said Jean or son Absalom as
 the case may be heirs Executors administrators or assigns and the
 said William Hutchison for myself my heirs Executors and
 Administrators do shall and will warrant and defend the
 aforesaid Negro Boy against all persons whatsoever and the
