Know all men by these presents that we Charles L Francisco and John Lewis & George Francisco are held and firmly bound unto the president and Directors of the Literary Fund in the sum of two Thousand Dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to the said president and Directors or their Successors we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents Sealed with our seals and dated this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 1821.

The condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bound Charles L Francisco hath been appointed by the Board of School Commissioners within and for Bath county Treasurer to said Board to act in all things required of him by Law as such now if the said Charles L Francisco shall faithfully apply Account for and pay all Monies which shall come to his hands by Virtue of his Office in such Manner and at such times as shall be required of him by a Resolution of the said Board and in all other things shall faithfully and lawfully discharge the duties of his said Office then the above Obligation to be Void else to remain in full force
