in Virginia being Verry Sick in Body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks to  
God and Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed  
for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that  
is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul to the  
Hands of God who gave it and for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be  
Buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing  
doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the Same again  
by the mighty power of God and as touching such Worldly Estate as I have I  
commend God to bless me in this life, I give devise and dispose of the Same in the  
following manner and form to wit, that is to say, after all my just debts are  
Paid be. I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Wife Jabbell Linn her  
horse saddle and Bridle and all my Household furniture and all my Grain  
in and out of the Ground at present with two Cows such as she shall  
Chose also if my said wife chuse to live with my son Adam Linn in that

case he shall be obliged to provide for her a Reasonable maintenance  
during her Widowhood also I give and Bequeath to my said beloved  
Wife Isabella Linn Twenty five Pounds Current money of Pennsylvania  
to be put in the hands of my Son in law James Young for the only purpose of  
Giving it to my Beloved Wife as she stands in need of it. They with horse  
and furniture with the Household furniture and Twenty five Pounds &  
two Cords as aforesaid I give unto my said Beloved wife to her and her  
heirs and assigns forever. Item I also give and Bequeath to my Son  
Joseph Linn all my Land on that Side of the line where his improvement  
now is I say the line marked by my order between my said Son Joseph  
and Adam Linn <sup>said</sup> by Joseph Linn David Beard James Keasey also I  
give my Son Joseph Linn my Grey Horse and the hind wheels of my  
Waggon they which said Land as above with my said Grey Horse and  
two hind wheels of my Waggon I give and Bequeath to my Son Joseph  
Linn to him and his heirs and assigns forever. Item, I also give  
and Bequeath to my Son Joseph Linn <sup>all my Lands</sup> that I own or shall own

Wife Isabella Linn Twenty five Pounds Current money of Pennsylvania  
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and furniture with the Household furniture and Twenty five Pounds &  
two Cords aforesaid I give unto my said Beloved wife to her and her  
heirs and assigns forever. Item I also give and Bequeath to my Son  
Joseph Linn all my Land on that Side of the line where his improvement  
now is. I say the line marked by my Order between my said Sons Joseph  
and Adam Linn by Joseph Linn David Beard James Keasey also I  
give my Son Joseph Linn my Grey Horse and the hind wheels of my  
Waggon they which said Land as above with my said Grey Horse and  
two hind wheels of my Waggon I give and Bequeath to my Son Joseph  
Linn to him and his heirs and assigns forever. Item, I also give  
and Bequeath to my Son Adam Linn <sup>all my Land</sup> on that Side of the above

mentioned line where my House and Improvements are including said

Improvements and Purtenance to my Son Adam Senn to him  
his heirs and assigns forever I also give and Bequeath to my said  
Son Adam Senn all the Remainder of said Waggon with its  
appurtenance with my Plow and all my other Plantation Utensils  
to said Adam Senn to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved daughter Martha Craig  
Twenty Shillings Current money to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Agnes Young Twenty  
Shillings Current money to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I also give and Bequeath to my daughter Mary Carson  
Twenty Shillings Current money to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I also give and Bequeath to my Son Joseph Senn and  
Adam Senn all my Cloaths all the Remainder of my money with  
all my outstanding debts here in Pennsylvania or else where with

the Remainder of all my Cattle.

The Remainder of all my Cattle and Hogs to be Equally Divided  
Between my Said Sons Joseph and Adam Sinner to them and their  
heirs and assigns forever, Also I do hereby utterly disallow revoke  
and disannul all and every other Former Testament Wills and  
Legacies bequests and exectors by me in any wise before this Time  
Named nilld and Bequeath, Ratifying and Confirming this  
within and no other to be my Last will and Testament In  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this  
Twenty first day of October 1771. I hereby Constitute and  
Appoint my Son Joseph Sinner and James Young to be  
Executors of this my Last will and Testament &c

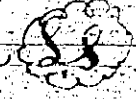

At a Court held for Bedford County March 24. 1772.

This last will and Testament of Adam Linn dec'd. was proved by the Oaths of Robert Ewing and Micajah Stone witnesses thereto subscribed and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Joseph Linn one of the Executors therein Named who made Oath thereto Certificate is granted him for obtaining Probate thereof in due form giving Security whereupon he Together with James Young and William Carson his Securities entered into and Acknowledged their Bond in the Penalty of four hundred Pounds for the said Joseph Linn's due & faithful Administration of the said decedent's Estate and Performance of his Will Liberty being Reserved to the other Executor named in the said Will to join in the Probate thereof when he shall think fit.
