this my Last Will & Testament that is to say principally & first of
all I give & Recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty
god & my Body I Recommend to the earth to be buried in a

decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall
Receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as
Touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased
god to bless me with in this life I give demise & dispose of

the same in the following manner & form. first I give &
bequeath to Mary Dabney my beloved wife all my Lands &
plantation whereon I now live likewise all my stocks & things

plantation where on I now live & I give all my stock & house
hold furniture to enjoy the same during her natural life or
widowhood & excepting two pieces of Land that I gave to my
son George Dalney to be at his disposal Immediately after
my Decease one of the said pieces of Land supposed to contain
forty acres beginning at a white oak on the dividing Line between
Newman Reins & myself & running a straight line to Williams
old pattern line the other piece beginning at a white oak in
Williams Old pattern Line thence new Lines to a small
branch & then down the said Branch to the said Pattern Line
the same supposed to contain fifteen acres then my Will &
desire is that the rest of my Land be equally Divided between
my two sons Cornelius Dalney & John Dalney & as for my
movable Estate my Will & desire is that it may be
equally Divided between Benjamin Dalney & Charles
Dalney Sarah Prattagatha Dalney & Anna Dalney my
children as for my two Daughters Nancy Overstreet &

0. Molly Turner I give & Bequeath five shillings a piece to be paid
out of my Movable Estate also I constitute make & ordain my son
George Dabney & William Hancock Executors of this my Last Will &
Testament I do hereby utterly Disallow Revoke & Disannul all &
every other former Testament Wills Legacies bequeast & Executors by
me in any wise before named Willed & Bequeathed ratifying &
confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament I do
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty third
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
Ninety two.
