appoint this to be my Last Will & Testament. Viz I lend to my
wife during her life all my moveable Estate at my decease Also the house
Plantation where I now live to be fully enjoyed by her After her decease
to be distributed as followeth Viz The 3^d Plantation containing 375
Acres to be equally divided between My two sons Henry & Daniel (they
maintaining my funeral Satisfaction for one third of said Land
my three sons Viz Henry, Daniel, & Samuel is to pay me ten pounds
each if I require it I give to my daughter Elizabeth & Alice one feather
Bed Furniture each the rest of my daughters Viz Abigail Ann
Mary & Sarah I give ten shillings each The residue of my Estate
after my Just Debts is paid I leave to my three sons Viz Henry
& Daniel & Samuel whom I appoint Executors to this my last Will &
Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
this 9th day of January 1796 Henry Brown (Sd)

I Michael Stone of the County of Bedford do hereby make
my last will & Testament in manner & form following that
is to say After the Payment of my Just debts & funeral expenses
I give to my wife Aphra Stone all my estate both real &
Personal for Educating her Natural life or Widowhood reserving to
my sons all except my son William the Liberty of Settlement
on the Land so soon as they become of age as also those of them
who have settled to become Peaceable Possessors of the same and
after my wife's decease I desire that the Land may be valued
& allotted to my sons in equal proportion I also desire that my
daughter be maintained
