Christ for life & Justification Secondly I give my body to the earth from whence
it was taken to be Buried in a Decent manner without pomp or Vanity
according to the Direction of my executor whom I shall hereafter decessate and
appoint. As to my worldly estate with which it has pleased God to Bless me
with I give & Dispose of as followeth. Item I bequeath to my Loving wife
Elizabeth during life the Land & Plantation whereon I now live with all my
household furniture & stock of every kind & after her Death to be equally Divided amongst
his five children (viz) Peter, Christopher, Nancy, & Miller. Item I give to my
son John five shillings. Item I give to my son Peter that tract of Land & Plantation
whereon he now lives to him & his heirs forever. Item I give to my Daughter
Malley Elizer five shillings. Item I give to my Daughter Winney Thompson
five shillings. Item I give to my Daughter Temperence Thompson five hundred
weight of Tobacco to be paid her out of the Last payment in a Bond I have on
William Thompson for six thousand weight of Tobacco. Item I give to my son
James one thousand weight of Tobacco out of the ^{last} payment of the above mentioned
Bond & the remainder of the above mentioned Bond for tobacco to be applyed to the

payment of my last Debts and if there be any left to be applied to the benefit of my
Loving wife & children after the Death of my Loving Wife my will and
Deser is that the stile that I have in Possession at this time be
given to my son Christopher when he comes to the age of twentyone years and
Lastly I do nominate & appoint my Loving friends Thomas Bate & Daniel
James & Matthew Bate whole & Sole Executors of this my last will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this seventh day of
October in the year of our Lord 1790.
