Sterling to be paid out of my Estate Item I give to my
Daughter Anna Borden one Shilling Sterling to be paid
out of my Estate Item I give to my Son William Good
one Shilling to be paid out of my Estate Item I give to my
Son Abraham Good one Shilling

to my Daughter Joannah I leave one Shilling Sterling to be
Paid out of my Estate. Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth
one Shilling Sterling to be paid out of my Estate, Item
I give to my Daughter Hannah Bennett one Shilling
Sterling to be paid out of my Estate, Item I give to my
Daughter Anna Blunden one Shilling Sterling to be paid
out of my Estate Item I give to my Son William Goad
one Shilling to be paid out of my Estate Item I give to my
Son Abraham Goad one Shilling Sterling to be paid out of
my Estate Item I give to my Son Robert Goad one Shilling
Sterling to be paid out of my Estate, Item I send to my son
William Goad the life of my cow known by the name of Cleopom
with her increase till his son John shall come to the age of
Twenty one years and then the property to be in John

But if the said John should Die without Issue then the said
 Leonard her Increase to be Divided amongst the Rest of my
 son Williams children. Then I Give to my son Abraham Goad
 the use of my house known by the Name of Steer with her In-
 crease till his son James shall come to the age of Twenty
