I Commit to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion
of my Executor hereafter Named, and for the settling of my
Temporal Estate and such Goods Chattles and Debts as it hath
pleased God to bestow upon me I do Order give and dispose
of the same in manner and form following, that is to say
Inprimis, I give and bequeath unto my dear and Loving
wife Betty Green all my Lands that I bought of Robert
Mead lying on Mice Creek during her natural life and
at her decease, Her I give and bequeath the above said
Land to my oldest Son James Green to have and to hold forever.
Her I give and Bequeath unto my well beloved wife all
my Goods and Chattles to have and to hold during her life and

and at the end of said Term my Goods and Chattles to be sold
or otherwise to be Equally divided between my other two
Children viz Barnabus Green and Tabitha Green to have and
to hold as their own Property forever, further more I will that
my Children be Taught to Read my two Sons be Taught to
write and Cypher their Schooling to be paid out of said
Estate or otherwise as my Executor shall Order it. And I
heraby make Ordain and Apoint my well beloved wife
my full and Sole Executrix of this my last Will and
Testament hereby revoking and Disannulling and making
Void all former Wills and Bequests by me made and
Declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament
and none other, In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 27th Day of January 1775
