death do make this my last Will & Testament Viz. I Bequeath my soul to God who
gave it and my body to the Earth to be Buried in a decent manner at the discretion of
my Executor in sure and certain Hope of the Resurrection at the last day through
the merits of our Lord and Saver Jesus Christ as for my worldly Estate with which
God has graciously been pleased to Bless me I dispose of as follows Viz.
Item my will is that my Goods I leave to my son Thomas Greer and as for the rest
of my Estate both real & personal shall be Equally divided amongst
all my Children after all my just debts & funeral Charges is fully paid
and I do heartily Institute and appoint my Beloved Wife Anna my my
True and Lawfull Executor of this my last Will and Testament Calling
all Other have hearunto set my hand and Seal this 12th day of October Anno
1766.
