The final answer to the Last Will & Testament
of Michael Rees dec. bearing date the 20th of January 1897
was exhibited in court and proved by the oath of Christopher
Black and Henry John Wootcher, the witnesses subscribed for and to be
recorded. Michael Rees the only executor appointed in the
will, state refusing to qualify. Whereupon the said Michael
Rees and Christopher Black came into court and made oath
and together with Humphrey Sharp and Samuel Bead then
securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum
of five thousand dollars conditioned as the Law Directs
Certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of Admin-
istration on said decedent's estate with the will annexed
in due form.
