the Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its
resurrection from thence at the Last day ... I Give to my
dear & Loving wife Beaceable Possession of all my real & personal Estate
during her Life or Widowhood but that first of all that all my Just & Lawful
Debts be first paid & that after the Death of my Loving wife that all &
every part of my Estate that is then in being be Equally divided among all
my children then born & to be born & And further more I do hereby constitute
& appoint my Loving wife my Executor for one party. My son Thomas
Bullen of the other party to execute this my Will & Testament. In
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set hand & seal this first Day of
January 1790

pounds Conditioned for the true & faithful administration of the said Decedent's
Estate & performance of his Will Liberty being reserved the Ex^{rs} named in the said Will
