

 day of June 1804

This last Will and Testaments of Reuben
 Dollard dec^d was exhibited in Court by Sarah Dollard the Executrix
 therein named, & proved by the Oaths of Mary Hobbs & James Hobbs
 the subscribing Witnesses & ordered to be recorded and on the motion
 of the said Executrix who made oath together with Bartholomew
 Gaston & William Cooper her Sureties entered into Bond in
 the sum of five Hundred Dollars conditioned according to Law
 certificate is granted her for obtaining probate thereof in due form liberty
 being reserved to the other Executors to join in the probate when they
 shall think fit
