Day of March one Thousand seven Hundred and sixty four
I Thomas Dixon of the parish of Mufatt and County of Bedford
Virginia being in perfect sense and Memory thanke to god for
the same calling to mind the mortality of my Body and
Knowing that it is appointed for all men to Die Do make and
Ordain this my Last will and Testament in Manner and
form following that is to say Principally and first of all
I give my soul to god who gave it me Trusting that through
the Merits and Merits of Jesus Christ my blessed Saviour and
Redeemer to Receive the same again with full Pardon for all
my sins committed in this Life and be Received into Eternal
Happiness and my body I give to the earth to be Christian
like Buried at the Discreption of my Executors and Executors
Hereby Witnessed

Day of Month one Thousand seven Hundred and forty five
I Thomas Dixon of the parish of Muscutt and County of Bedford
Virginia being in perfect sense and Memory thanks to god for
the same Calling to mind the mortality of my Body And
Knowing that it is appointed for all men to Die Do make and
Ordain this my Last will and Testament in Manner and
form following that is to say Principally and first of all
I give my soul to god who gave it me Trusting that through

Like Bred at the Discretion of my Executors and Executor
Hereafter Named and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith

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God has been pleased to bless me with in this Life I give in
Manner and form following Viz, I Give it to my will and Des-
ire and Lend to my Dear and Loving wife Ann Dixon the man-
or place whereon I now live with all the Stock Cattle Hogg
Houses and Implements of Husbandry also all Household furniture
we also give pounds Sterling the one third part of the Rent
of a Tract of Land now Inclosed in Ireland to my will and
Desire that no part of my Estate be appraised or sold more
then for my Just Debts untill after my Decease I Give to
Mary McNamee one Shilling Sterling, I Give unto
John Dixon five Shillings Sterling I Give unto George
Dixon a Bond of James Mathis for Eighty pounds also one feather
Bed & furniture after my wife's Decease to her heirs
& assigns I Give unto Jane Wilton Marrying one Cow
& Calf my Land and all the Implements therein belonging

my my and all the Implements hereunto Belonging
Them I give unto James Dixon the maner place whereon I now
Live after my suffer Disease also all the Stock and Household fur-
niture & Impements off the Land to him his heirs & assigns
forever And I do appoint Ann Dixon my Loving wife Executrix
and James Dixon Executor of this my Last will & Testament as
Witness my Hand and seal this 31 Day of March 1764
