

Court held for Bedford County 22 June 1778
This last Will and Testament of Thomas Murphy Deceased was proved
by the Oaths of George Lookey and James Brown the Jurors sworn
and ordered to be recorded and on the Motion of Oliver Murphy
the Executors therein named who made both their Certificate against
Fee for Obtaining Probate in due form giving security whereupon
he Together with James Brown and James Brown his securities enter
into and acknowledge their Bond in the sum of £1000
and provide for the due and faithful Administration
of the said decedent's Estate and Performance of his Will - Leaving
nothing reserved for Robert Field the other Executor named in the said
Will to join in the Probate thereof when he shall think fit
