 make over and declare this Instrument written with my own hand to be my last Will and
 Testament revoking all others. I prescribe, all my debts & funeral expenses to be paid ^{and specially} actually
 paid except the legacies coming to heirs of Caleb Ewing deceased now residing in the State
 of Kentucky to my dear & well beloved wife Anna Ewing & Mitchell Ewing my
 brothers & to whom I devised & gave and bequeathed my whole estate annual & personal and
 every part thereof to them & their heirs, the latter (forever) having to the legatees of Caleb
 Ewing in the State of Kentucky that is to say Polly & Doty White in six months after distribution
 shall take place of my estate one hundred dollars each. Also at the end of that date one
 hundred more to each of them with their Partners estate papers bonds & that may be
 coming to them. Nothing in the above sections is to be construed as to prohibit my well
 beloved wife from the entire and full benefit of my negro man Sam so long as she is my
 widow. Also all my books of Law and religious books of every kind I give & bequeath to
 Mitchell Ewing. It is also my will that Elizabeth Shurby & Eliza should have a conveyance
 made of 150 Acres of Land that they have now taken not conveyed on the East by the lines
 marked contained in the bond given them. I give and bequeath to my nephew Mitchell
 Ewing all that tract of Land he now lives on situated on the branch the Otter river, bounded
 by Deeds of Barbara and my own lines 1400 acres. And lastly I do hereby constitute
 my trusty friends Isaac St. Mitchell Ewing & Anna Ewing my lawful Executors
 of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 & affixed my seal the 24th day of July in the year of our Lord 1810.
