Will, County of Bedford being weak & sick in body but of Perfect sense
and Memory and calling to Remembrance the Mortality of my
body & knowing that all Flesh must yeeld to Death when please
God to call do make constitute Ordain & appoint this my last
Will & Testament in Manner and form following I. I willed
give & commit my soul to god that give it and my Body I commit
to the earth from whence it came to be buried in a Christian
like Manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
named. I give to my Father one mare & saddle & my Plantation
Tooles I give to my wife Sarah Moody all the rest of my
Estate one mare halt & all my household stuff my stock of
cattle & hogs & my crop of corn & fodder. I do nominate and
appoint my wife Sarah Moody and ^{William} Trueman my executors of
this last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have set
my hand & seal this 9th day of December 1794

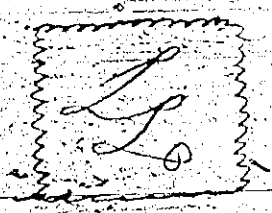

This Last Will & Testament of William Moody Deceased was proved by the
Oaths of John Moody & John W. Blain Witnesses whose names are thereunto
subscribed & Ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of Sarah Moody the
Executrix therein named who made oath that Certificate is granted her
for obtaining probate thereof in due form on giving security whereupon
she together with Stephen Hail her security entered into and Acknowledged
this bond in the Penalty of two hundred pounds Conditioned for the
said Executrix due & faithful administration of said Decedents Estate
and Performance of his Will, Liberty being reserved to William
Truman the Executor therein named to claim the Probate thereof
when he shall think fit.
