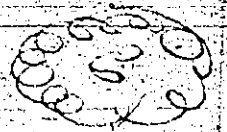


I know all men by these presents that I William
 Willman of Bedford County in Virginia do make and
 publish this my last will and Testament respecting such
 Worldly Estate as I have been favored with. and first I
 will that all my just Debts and funeral charges be paid
 out of my my Estate by my Executors hereafter named.
 2^d I give unto my beloved Wife Anna Willman the Plantation
 whereon I now live during her natural life and after
 I give unto my beloved Wife my bedding more or less
 such as she may please and as she shall please on the place
 or Plantation and the Lumber of her young Black people
 with the things which were to her use of her useable to her
 of her own acquisitions recorded and as my Wiveschell and
 Kitchen furniture except one Jacob Bed and furniture
 and I shall mention hereafter. 3rd I give and bequeath
 unto my Son John Willman the Sum of two Hundred and
 thirty three pounds nine shillings and three pence which I
 at sundry times have him as of account. 4th I give and
 bequeath unto my Son Isaac Willman the Land and Plantation
 whereon I now live and after the Death of my beloved Wife also
 a Sum of money bequeathed to him and his Heirs. 5th I will
 that my Son and that my Son John purchased for me of Cole
 in Grayson County be sold and out of the amount of sales
 be given to my Son John to purchase that sum of land and
 in that he should have and serve on grounds I
 have not mentioned in my will.

in and to my great regret I have been obliged to
sell the said land to my children for the purpose of obtaining
money to the said land. I have also sold to my
children the balance arising from the sale
of the above said land. I have also sold to my children
this spring and a saddle purchased for me by me as a
task. I have also sold to my children two years of the aged horse
last mentioned. I have also sold to my children the horse
which I have sold to the like property. I do hereby nominate
constituted and appointed and by these presents have nominated
constituted and appointed my son Israel Wildman and
My son Samuel Hague Executors to this my last will
and Testament making void all former Wills by me
made. I have also sold to my children and assigned
my son the twenty dollar note of the 10th month in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five
1805.
