In the Name of God, Amen. I Anna Gulliford of Botetourt County, State of Virginia, solemnly taken into Consideration My Mortality and reflecting that it is the appointment of Heaven that all must enter the Eternal World through the Gate of Death and being in possession of the full exercise of all my rational Powers of Mind for which I thank God I do by these presents constitute and make my last Will and Testament as follows to wit: First I resign my Immortal Soul to my God who I Trust through the Merits of my Divine Saviour will graciously accept the same & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian like Manner in the Churing hope of a Glorious & Triumphant Resurrection through my Gracious Saviour. Secondly after the payment of my funeral Expenses & all my just Debts it is my Will that my Negro Woman Selby & her Child be not parted & if her and her Child should be sold, that she shall be indulged with the Liberty of choosing her Master & leave and bequeath to my Grand daughters Anna Priscilla & Sarah Wilson thirty Dollars to be equally divided amongst them. I leave and bequeath to my son Allen Gulliford thirty dollars and the residue of my property consisting of the said Negro Woman & Child Money & Notes I leave & bequeath to my son James

between them and finally I do constitute and appoint my well
beloved son in law George McConkey the executor of this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the
19th day of January 1897.
