

Some Revolutionary Records of Botetourt Co., Va. - Aug., 1782

The following is an exact copy of original records found in the basement of the courthouse, in Fincastle, Botetourt County, Virginia. Some names were too faded to be legible, and a part was missing.

"At a meeting of the field officers this thirty-first of August, 1782, for the county of Botetourt, for the purpose of carrying into Execution this state's quota of Troops to serve the United States Army for the Term of three years, or during the War. Present, George Skillern, County Lieut., Hugh Crockett, Colo., Wm. McClenehan, Lieut. Colo., Patr. Lockhart, Majr., James Breckenridge appointed Clerk, who took the Oath by Law required, Adam Peck appointed Martial."
