empower them to employ a fit & suitable person to close my medical accounts
and to pay him out of my Estate for his services, and I do request them to pay
all my just debts and in order to effect that purpose should the fund arising
from the debts due me not be sufficient or recovered in time I do hereby
direct them to make sale of such property as my wife Elizabeth W. Palmore
may designate for that purpose, and after that end is effected the entire residue
of my estate I do hereby give & bequeath to my wife dear & beloved wife Elizabeth
W. Palmore to have and to hold for ever, for her self, use & benefit I do recommend
unto her to keep my niece Rebecca Palmore with her but if it should so
happen that Rebecca's parents should wish to take her home to give her
such present as she may think fit as an Evidence of my affection for her
And lastly I do hereby appoint & constitute my friend Capt. Daniel Rowland
my wife Elizabeth W. Palmore the sole Executors of this my last will &
Testament and it is my special desire that they may be permitted to qualify
