In the name of God amen I Christian Hopps of the County of Potomac State of Virginia being weak in Body but of sound mind and disposing memory for which I thank God and calling to mind the immortality of human life and being desirous of disposing of all such worldly estate as hath pleased God to bless me with I give and bequeath the same in manner following To wit - 1st I direct that my Executors hereafter named pay all my Just Debts and burial Expenses &c. Being desirous to do equal Justice to my Children and Grand Children I have devised my tract of land lying on the south side of James River containing 695 Acres the plat of the division bear date the 23rd day of August 1808 and Recorded in the Landings Office of this County and with it designated by them to be sold to my Son Henry Daughters one Mary and her heirs for ever

One Hundred and ten acres of land including my Grist mill agreeable
to the above mentioned plat of Division and designated by lot No. 1 - which
I value to seven Hundred and sixty Dollars and 93 cents $\frac{1}{4}$ I give and
Devise to my two Grand Children Christian Coffer & Mary Coffer formerly
Mary Coffer children of my son George Coffer ~~and~~ one Hundred and
twenty acres of land to be Equally Divided between them agreeable to quan-
tity and quality with this Exception that I give the one half of the Spring
and Spring House to my aforesaid Daughter Eve Rule and her heirs
Ever said land includes my Dwelling House & saw mill and in the plat
Division as designated by lot No. 2 - and valued at Eight Hundred and
seven Dollars & 60 cents $\frac{1}{2}$ I give to my Daughter Reganah Custer & her
heirs for ever one Hundred and ~~one~~ ^{one} acre of land which she now lives
on Except one half acre on which there is a School House which half
acre I devise may be used for school and public worship the land aforesaid
is designated on the plat of Division by lot No. 3 which I value
to seven hundred and ~~seventy~~ ^{eighty} dollars and sixty cents $\frac{1}{2}$ I give to my
Daughter Barbara Beraker and ~~her~~ heirs for ever one Hundred and seventeen
acres of land which she now lives on and is designated in the plat of Divi-
sion by lot No. 4 which I value to six Hundred and sixty six dollars
and sixty seven cents But if the said Barbara dies without any lawful
Issue the said lot of land is to be divided between my Children and
Grand Children or their representatives according to the laws of dis-
tribution and if her Husband Adam Beraker survives her the said
Barbara he shall hold the said lot of land during his natural life

Barbara we shall hold the said 10th of land during her natural life
yth I give to my Daughter Dorothy Peule and her Heirs for ever
One Hundred and Eleven Acres of Land which she has now ^{now} possession
of and is designated in the plat of Division by lot No 5 which I
value to five ^{four} thousand and ^{four} hundred & sixty cents 8th I Give to
my Daughter Elizabeth Young and her Heirs for ever One Hundred and
thirty two Acres of Land which she now possesses and designated
in the plat of Division by lot No 6 which I value at ^{four} thousand
and seventy one dollars and 6 cents 9th I direct that all my estate
whether in land or nature so ever it may be not hereon before disposed
of be Equally Divided among my 6 children and Grand Children accor-
ding to the laws of distribution 10th Lastly I nominate and appoint
Adam Besaker and ^{to} John Besaker Executors of this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 5th day of April
in the Year of Our Lord 1828.
