cretion of my Executors and as touching my worldly Estate whereunto
it has pleased God to Bless me In this life I give and bequeath in
the following manner First I will unto my beloved wife my Bed &
Bedstead & furniture & my Cupboard & my House hold Table my

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Stove & as much household furniture as she may need and
one cow and Beef my provision where we now live as long as she lives for
which my son Abraham is to have a yearly credit on his Bonds twenty
Dollars for year as long as she lives further is my will that my Executors
furnish my sd Widow plentifully with flower Commear Beef and pork
as much as she may need as long as she may live with every other neff
sundry articles for a comfortable living Second I will unto my son
