In the name of God Amen I Edward Lloyd of the County of Mattocks and State of Virginia
being weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this to be my
last will and Testament in manner and form following in the first place I direct all
my Just Debts to be paid out of my Estate by my Executor herein after named hereby
empowering them to use and exercise their own discretion in selling any part of my
property they may deem Expedient to affect that Object I Give and bequeath to my
beloved wife Dorinda Lloyd my House and Lot in the Town of Fincastle purchased
from Jacob Sullivan together with all my Household and Kitchen furniture and every
other species of personal property of which I die possessed of to her for ever I also
Give to my beloved wife Dorinda Lloyd an Obligation held on Charles Johnson
of this County for the sum of twenty one Hundred Dollars with the Interest that
may have accrued at the time of my death and thereafter to her for ever I also
Give to my beloved wife Dorinda Lloyd the sum of three thousand One Hundred
and twenty five dollars I have deposited in the Farmers Bank of Virginia at Lynchburg
with the Interest that has accrued on the same to her for ever and every other spe-
cies of property both real and personal which I die possessed of I give and bequeath
to my said Wife to her for ever hereby ratifying and confirming this and this only
to be my last will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 28th Day of December in the Year of our Lord 1830
and I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Dorinda Lloyd whole and sole executrix of
this my last will and Testament with a request that the County Court of Mattocks
will permit her to qualify without giving bond and security
