do make and publish this Instrument of Writing to be my last
Will and Testament and do hereby revoke all others heretofore by me made
in my Will that my body be decently buried by my Executor hereafter named
my soul & reason to the almighty Creator in full hope of my Eternal
happiness through the merits of my blessed redeemer and as it respects my
Estate I leave as follows to wit: I direct that all my last debts be
paid & funeral Expenses To my Son Leet Lacklin I give him the Tract
land that I purchased from my Son Alfred To my Son Benoni Lacklin
I give him my tracts of land that I purchased William Lacklin & Ann
Tanschie = To my Daughter Mary Ann Lacklin I give her my Tract of land
that I purchased from Melcher Taylor To my Son John
Lacklin & Luther Lacklin I give them my Tracts of Land that I purchased from
Christian Herrkhauser & Jerry Samuel Lerul at the Death of their mother
To my Daughter Lida I give her my young mare & my young mare
Mare & four Hundred Dollars in Cash to be paid out of my estate in money
then one Hundred Dollars per year To my loving Wife Martha I give her
my negro girl Saline I also give her all the money on hand at my Death
such Debt as is to me owing I also give her the plantation whereon I now live
together with all my Slaves and their Increase (except such as is heretofore
given) during her life & all the houses bath & outhouses & Kitchen Furniture &

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Then one Hundred Dollars for year To my loving Wife Martha I give her
my negro girl Seline I also give her all the money on hand at my Death
such Debt as is to me owing I also give her the plantation whereon I now live
together with all my Slaves and their Increase (except such as I have before
given) During her life I all the horses cattle household & Kitchen Furniture &
mining utensils & Stock of every Description and at her Death the Slaves & their in-
crease I give to my Son John S Locklin & Luther Locklin together with all the
Stock of Horses cattle household & Kitchen furniture &c &c and as I have
heretofore given to my Son Alfred & Corbin Locklin what I conceive to be
their full proportion of my estate I make to them no further devise bequests &
nominate I appoint my neighbor Thos Wilson to be my Executor of this my last will
