

I Henry Cartmill, jun., of Botetourt County, Virginia, do hereby make my Last Will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first after the payment of my Debt and funeral expenses I give and bequeath to my brother John Cartmill and Thomas Cartmill my whole Estate of every description both real and personal. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said brother John and Thomas Cartmill Executors of this my Last Will and testament, hereby revoking all other or former wills or testaments by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 18th day of December 1834.
