

James Delzell: In the name of God, Amen, I James Delzell of the County of
Potomac and State of Virginia, do make and ordain this my last will and tes-
tament. First I give to my Sisters Sarah C. Delzell and Elizabeth F. Delzell
fee simple, all my Interest in the tract of land on which my mother now
lives which said tract was devised by my father, in parcels to myself and my brother
Hugh. Second. The residue of my personal estate, after the payment of my
just Debts, I give to my mother Sarah C. Delzell, and hereby appoint her
Executor of this my last will and Testament, and I further direct that no Security
be required of her in the administration of my Estate, and that no appraisement
or sale of my personal effects be made, except at her option.
Given under my hand and seal of office this 25th day of March 1832
