In the name of God Amen I John Wetzel late of Reading, Berks County and State of Pennsylvania, now of Salem Botetourt County and State of Virginia, being in ~~the~~ health but of sound mind aware of the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, do make this my Last will & Testament, to wit: I recommend my Soul to that merciful God from whom I received it, and my body to that dust from which it originated to be buried in a moderate yet decent manner. 2nd My funeral expenses first to be paid, and my other debts being but small to be discharged with all possible dispatch. 3rd All my property whether real or personal I give and bequeath to my beloved wife and Child forever, to be handed over by my executor, herein to be mentioned, to my wife for the mutual benefit and advantage of my said wife and Child, in such manner as the Executor may in his discretion and Judgment think proper.

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4th It is my wish that so soon as the funds may come into the Executor's hands, he may purchase that small Farmement, now in the possession of the Rev^d Mr. Humphreys, provided it can be obtained at a moderate price, or any other suitable property, which my said wife and my Executor may on consultation deem advisable, and if purchased to be deeded to said wife and Child. 5th I appoint my worthy friend George W. Shanker of Salem my sole Executor, with a request, that he will, as such, act of this my Last will and Testament, hereby revoking any which I may heretofore have made. Witness my hand and Seal this 10th day of July 1835.
