In the name of God, Amen, I Margaret Gough of the County of White
Tuck & State of Virginia do make and publish this Instrument of writing to
be my last will, & Testament and do hereby revoke all other wills made by me.
It is my will that my body be decently buried. My soul I resign to do almighty God
in full hopes of Eternal happiness. Through the merits of my beloved Redeemer
and as it respects my worldly estate I have no other will (to wit)
I direct that my Just Debt be paid & funeral expences, then to my
Daughter Elizabeth Patton & her heirs I will, & bequeath all my property
(namely one Potomac mare, Two cows, & calves, one Pot. & one Hittie
one Hobb, two stags, one furniture, & two wheels, & one Ox, one Goat,
Three Chickens, one captured raven; Lastly I appoint my neighbour J. R.
Lutland my Executor of this my last will & Testament. Witness my hand
and Seal this 6th Day of January 1832

I David break being in a delicate state of health but in a perfectly sane state of mind do make this my last will and testament as follows viz.

1st I do hereby declare that my Executor herein after named Thomas G. G. up my last will collect all the money due me and pay off all my debts.

2nd It is my will and desire that my Executor sell my negro woman named Silly & her children named Brice, Sam & John on such payment & with reasonable care the highest price and make them out to accomplish the following objects.

3rd It is my will and desire that the funds arising from the sale of the negro and any other surplus funds be applied to the purchase of a farm & a house for my family.

4th It is my will and desire that the farm purchased as aforesaid shall be so conveyed as to secure it as a home for my wife and children until the youngest child is of age such child to have the benefit of it as a home and for a support until they are of age.
