I have heretofore kept a memorandum of what I have given them, which can be ascertained if they have over and above that sum they are to pay back. Next and fourthly I will unto my three Daughters Catherine Gish, Elizabeth Stofinger and Susannah Snider the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars each. I have likewise kept a memorandum that may be ascertained. Next I will unto my grand daughter Jacob Snider daughter Catherine one bed and bedstead with some furniture; my youngest daughter Susanna never married and has lived with us many years after her age of 31 years has been very faithful for which she shall be recompensed & shall after her mother's decease become the sole heir of my house and land forever.
