sole Executor of this my last Will and testament thus first I give
and bequeath to my daughter Martha Rhodia one negro boy named
David for her to keep for ever then to my daughter Sarah
Skidmore I give and bequeath one Negro woman named Betty
and two children names Will and Jacob and the said woman (increased)
to be her forever and not to be sold) without the consent also of
bequeath to her the s^r Sarah Skidmore one Cupboard one bed bedding
and trunks to be her and I do utterly make void all former
Wills and testaments and confirm this and only this to be my last
will and testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and the 21st day of March 1829
