do declare this instrument and every page thereof to be my  
last will and Testament Revoking all others to wit  
Item I give unto the Heirs of my son William White one  
dollar each having given unto him as much as I intended  
Item I give unto my Daughter Nancy Walton and her Heirs for  
ever two hundred and ten acres of land adjoining John  
Johnson and John Circle also ninety four acres on the  
south side of Roan Oak River and adjoining the land of  
William Walton Senior to my Son Edmund P White  
I give one half of the tract of land called Red Taylor  
Tract near New London in Campbell & Bedford Counties  
in addition to what I have heretofore given him and to his  
Heirs for ever Item I give unto my Son Samuel and  
his Heirs for ever the tract of land called Mount Hope  
situated on the south side of the main Road and above  
the head of Roan Oak River in Montgomery County  
also one half of Red Taylor Tract near New London  
Item I give to my Daughter Sally - Item I give one hundred  
Dollars in addition to what I have heretofore given her  
Item the Dwelling House and the land attached thereto  
all their appurtenances to remain as it now stands as a  
home for the same

and my dependances to remain as it now stands as a  
home for the single children which are now with me during  
their lives of celibacy and when Catharine Polina  
or Jane think proper to get married each one shall be entitled  
to three working hands and three small ones a horse  
saddle & Bridle a bed & Bed and furniture a Bureau  
cow & calf to Grasser I give the ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> acre field  
and all the Woods land attaches thereto which I believe to  
be about Two Hundred & ten acres being on the south side
