In the name of God amen I Stephen Holstine in the County of Botetourt and State of Virginia now in a low State of health yet retaining my right mind and senses and balking to mind the shortness of life and the certainty of death now disposed of my personal property I do devise my Son Maria Holstine to have my hunting gun and shot pouch and one pair of Horse gears which he has in possession all the rest of my property namely horses cattle money and ~~bedding~~ bedding and bed to be after my just debts are paid I will to my beloved wife former Jane Holstine
