I Thomas Gooden of the County of Botetourt & State of Virginia
hereby make my last will & testament in manner & form following
That is to say. I give to my Wife Martha
Gooden the tract of land I now live on & a tract adjoining
known by the name of Shubert Bottoms during her natural life &
at her death to be equally divided in quantity & quality between
two children John & Mary Ann Gooden which said tracts
I give to them & their heirs for ever after the death of my said Wife
I also give to my Wife Martha Gooden three negroes Phineas
& George during her natural life & after her death to my son John
& his heirs for ever. I also give to my wife Martha three
other negroes Stanford, Luda & Pleasant. while she lives or until
my Daughter Mary Ann Marries & on either event taking place I
give the said negroes Stanford, Luda & Pleasant to my said
Daughter Mary Ann Gooden & her heirs for ever. I also give
my Wife Martha Gooden all my stock & farming utensils &
every thing during her natural life except one horse Buckle &
saddled with seventy five dollars & three cows which I give

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to my daughter Mary Ann at her marriage or at the death of
 my said wife so her forever after that the residue of said stock & farm
 my intended to be equally divided between my two children John
 & Mary Godwin I also give to my wife Martha Godwin
 all my household & kitchen furniture during her natural
 life & after her death I give to my daughter Mary Ann Godwin
 two good beds a double coverlet, a white counterpane & pillow quilt
 a pair of Blankets two hair sheets pillow & pillow slips bath-
 towels bedstead & curtains & under beds all articles above mentioned
 to each bed also cupboards & furniture also my mahogany bureau
 & clock & folding leaf table, the residue of said household &
 kitchen furniture Botetourt County Virginia Wills 1824-1829
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 dren John & Mary Ann Godwin forever. I give unto my son
 John Godwin all the tract of land which he now lives on &
 which I purchased of Roger Malory to him & his heirs forever.
 I also give unto my said son John a negro boy named Fide
 which he has possession of & all other property that he has pos-
 session of to him forever. I give to my daughter Mary Ann
 Godwin three tracts of land containing about 181 Aors lying
 on James River two on the south the other opposit on the north
 side of said River & which Leonard Morton now rents to
 her & her heirs for ever. The said Morton's lease expires on the first
 day of March 1832. I give the use & benefit of said lease to

My wife Martha Goodwin to her for ever. I give also
to my said daughter Mary Ann five hundred dollars to be
paid out of my bonded debts at her marriage or the death
of my said wife Martha the balance of all my bonded debts I
give unto my son John Goodwin to him & his heirs for ever all
the rest of my estates both real & personal of what nature or
kind soever it may be not herein before particularly disposed
of & same may be equally divided among my two children here-
in before named which I give to them their heirs executors
administrators & assigns forever. — I do hereby constitute

appoint my son John Goodwin executor of my last will
& testament hereby revoking all others or former wills or
testaments by me heretofore made in writing whereby I
have heretofore set my hand & affixed my seal this 30th day
of June 1828.
