Be it remembered that I Valentine Miller of Orange Creek being in  
declining health but of sound mind, do this fifteenth day of February A.D.  
One thousand Eight hundred and thirty six make this my last will &  
testament as follows viz. To my three Daughters Elizabeth, Catherine &  
Sophia I give and bequeath all my land together with the stock and  
farming utensils as also the household and kitchen furniture in manner  
following. They are to maintain me during life, procure my body a  
decent burial and pay all outstanding debts, and in ten years after my  
decease (or so soon as convenient) pay to my Daughter Elizabeth Turner  
Sixty Dollars, and to my Daughter Margaret Carper Thirty Five Dollars -  
said sums to be received <sup>whenever offered</sup>, but no compulsory measures used  
to enforce payment. To my Son George I bequeath One Dollar, besides re-  
mitting One hundred and Eight Dollars for a year rent due me. Said  
Dollar to be paid six months after my decease. To my Son Francis  
son George I bequeath the sum of Fifty Dollars to be paid when he  
attains the age of twenty one years by my said three Daughters. Pro-  
vided that my said son Francis may have the use of said Fifty Dollars  
from the time it can be made, till said George is of age, by securing  
it. The land and appurtenances to be equally divided, or disposed of by  
themselves, 3 said daughters, or disinterested referees. If one of my three  
said daughters die single, my will is that her interest in said land  
revert to the other two. All parties satisfied with this my last will  
and testament shall not be entitled to one cent.
