(viz) after all my just Debts are paid I Give and Bequeath to my Brother
David one Half of my Land and the other Half to my Sister Rebecca
Little I do also allow my Saddle and my ~~watch~~ Silver Watch and Gun and my
books to be Sold by my Executor also what notes I have in my Hand to be
Collected. I do allow all my Expenses to be first paid and my just Debts
and all the Surplus Money to be divided between my other Brothers
and Sisters. I do also allow my Clothing to be Given to my Brother John Little
I do appoint my said Brother John my Executor for my Property in Virginia
and I do also appoint as Co-Executor Alex^r McNell and John Robertson
my Executors for my Property in the State of Indiana, to wit my House
and Land then situate this day of Dec^r 1840
