In the name of God Amen I William Smiley of the County of Botetourt and State of Virginia being weak in body but sound in mind and of a disposing disposition do make this my last will and Testament 1st I desire that all my personal property be immediately sold after my decease and out of the money arising therefrom pay my Just Debts and funeral Expenses as he proved by my Executor here after mentioned 2^dly after the payment of my debts and funeral Expenses I give to my wife Jane Smiley
