all men once to die and being in a perfect sound and disposing mind and memory
do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in manner following to witness
I promise that all my Justs be paid Item I leave unto my wife Anne Griffiths
my land and plantation with all my stock of every description and all my household
furniture of every description during the term of her Natural life and after her death
to be divided in manner following. Item I give to my son Thomas Griffiths my wife
saw to be delivered him after my decease to him and his heirs forever Item I give
to my son Joseph Griffiths two Dollars. Item I give to my son John Griffiths one
dollar Item I give to my son James Griffiths one half of my land together
with one half of my stocks of every kind together with one half of my plantation
Item together with one half of all my household and Kitchen furniture of
every description to be delivered him after the decease of my wife Item I give to my
daughter Sarah Barret two dollars. Item I give to my daughter Nancy two dollars
Item I give to my grandson Richard Griffiths the bottome bay mare is now big with
the access of his grandmother whom and his heirs forever provided nevertheless
that my said grandson shall stay with his grandfather until he reaches the age
of twenty five years. It is my will and desire that all my estate not specified
