In the Name of God. Men. I John Bennitt of the County of Brunswick and State of Virginia, being very sick and weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of the Body and knowing it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament First of all I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that give it, and my Body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner and as for what the Lord has intrusted me with in this world, I dispose of in the following manner I give I lend to my beloved wife Elisabeth Bennitt the care of my Soul and Administration with all my Stock of all kinds and House hold and Kitchen furniture that may remain after paying all my just debts during her natural life or widowhood and after her decease my Will is that what remains may be equally divided among all my then living Children I give to my Son Benjamin Bennitt all my Black Smiths Tools of all kinds to him and his heirs forever I do nominate and appoint Featherston Sadler and John Dugger Executors of this my last Will and Testament Revoking all others heretofore made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Seventeenth day of June one thousand seven hundred and ninety Eight, Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of
