In the name of God amen I Charles B. Jones of the County of Brunswick and parish of Saint Andrews do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit, I lend unto my dear and loving wife Sarah Jones during her natural life the lands and premises that I now live and at her death I give the said land and plantation to my said children that she from a variety of circumstances appears to be big with me a Male or female together with one half of all my other estate as well as as, personal in possession, reversion and remainder but in case my said wife should not be with child or should it be born dead or die before it arrives to the age of Twenty one years or marries I give the said lands and other estate to my said wife Sarah Jones as also the rest and residue of my estate to her and her heirs forever — I do constitute and appoint my said Wife Sarah Jones my whole and Sole executrix of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 12th day of August 1797
