In the Name of God Amen, I Daniel Huff of

the County of Brunswick and a State of Virginia being in a sound state of  
Health but in perfect mind & memory do make this my last Will & Testament

that is to say principally & <sup>it</sup> I leave unto my dear wife Ruthy during  
her life or widowhood, Pedro Gileas, Lucy, James, Bill, Henry & Turner,  
the Home plantation containing all the lands thereon on the lower Run  
of the Pigeon Roast, with as much of the stock & plantations & utensils as  
she sees cause to keep. My will is that my lands on the east side  
of Samuel Mooreys Spring branch known by the name of Hesters and

Beckles, with my Waggon be sold to pay Daniel Huff's debts.

3. I give unto my Daughter Melly Hester all the property I leave her  
after her marriage, to her & her Heirs for ever.

4. I give unto my two sons William and Lucy all the rest of my lands  
to be equally divided between them by his good son.

5. I give unto my four youngest children after my wife's decease all the  
tract of land that I leave to her to be equally divided among them all

6. I give unto my two eldest Sons Lucy, James, William Huff

William, Lucy, Elizabeth, Daniel, Ruthy & their heirs for ever of my Estate

that has not been before mentioned to be equally divided among them  
with all the property that I leave to my wife Ruthy & her land  
after her Death or Marriage. I also appoint my two eldest sons Lucy & William  
my two eldest Sons William and Lucy Huff to make my last  
Will and Testament Ratifying and bearing witness to this and  
in other to be my last Will and Testament.
