loving wife Polly two negroes George & Adams together with all my horses stock of all kinds household & kitchen furniture with

all and every Dollar that is owing to me also the lease of four years that I am now in possession of to her & her heirs forever

I appoint my father in law and George Wainwright my Executors of the said last will & testament Witness whereof I have hereunto

set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of November one thousand eight hundred
