William Farley do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following reciting all other wills by me made, I Item I give and bequeath to my son John Gee, all that tract of land on which he now lives also one negro woman named Frank, to him and his heirs forever. I Item I give unto my son in law Ephraim Parham, one negro man named Cummel to him and his heirs forever. I Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary better one negro woman named Jeffy, and her increase to her and her heirs forever. I Item I give unto my Grand daughters Tabithy Rivers and Judy Rivers one negro Girl named Winny, and her increase to be equally divided between my said Grand daughters when the eldest shall arrive at the age of sixteen years old. I Item I give unto my daughter Susan Porter, every thing I formerly lent, except the negro Girl Winny already given to her two daughters Tabithy Rivers and Judy Rivers. I Item I give unto my son William Gee all that tract of land on which he now lives bounded by Meherrin River on the South, as also one negro boy named Adam, to him and his heirs forever. I Item I give unto my Daughter Penelope Porter one negro woman named Clarissa with her increase to her and her heirs forever. I I give unto my daughter Bridget Davis one negro Girl named Edy, to her and her heirs forever. I Item I give unto my son Joshua Gee, one negro man named Jerry, and one negro boy named Edmund, as also one tract of land lying in the County of Mecklenburg, formerly the property of Stephen Strange as also one tract of land, in North Carolina which land I purchased of Dennis Bradley. I Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza Garrison one negro woman named Mney to her and her heirs forever. I Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Gee all the land I own on the south side of Meherrin River in the County of Brunswick.
