 I Raleigh Highlower of the County of Brunswick & State of  
 Virginia being of Perfect Sense and Memory, do make and  
 Ordain this my last Will and Testament this 10 Day of May  
 Eighteen Hundred & one. I Give to my daughter Martha  
 the following Negroes to wit: Palance and her increases, Rose  
 Neas Onay, Great Bob, & Charles, also my right Title to the  
 Water Creek Mill on Crooked run, formerly known by the name  
 of Crooked run Jones's Mill. One third of the Stock of off  
 Cattle & Sheep & one Feather bed & Furniture to her & her heirs  
 forever. I Give to my niece Sarah Highlower, who now  
 lives with me, a Horse of the value of Fifteen pounds to  
 furnish out of my estate, I Ordain some Feather bed & Furniture  
 to her & her heirs for ever. I Give to my daughter <sup>brand</sup> Constant  
 Examination, who now lives with me, a Negro Girl of the value  
 of one hundred & fifty dollars to be furnished out of my estate to her  
 & her heirs forever. I Give unto my Son Gregory Highlower  
 all the Land I am possessed with all every thing that appertain  
 thereto, all my household & Kitchen furniture, that's not otherwise  
 disposed of, all the Stock of Horses & the residue of the Stock of all  
 kind that not otherwise disposed of, the following Negroes to wit:  
 Lark, Pat, & others, & all every thing that I have, & all my
