would Estate it hath pleased God to possess me with I give and dispose of as
follow (to wit). Item I give unto my son Kemmon Jones Green three Negroes named
Britt Harry and Sarah with all their future Increase also one feather Bed &
furniture one Iron Gray mare & filly of same colour nine head of hogs & three head
of cattle all of which he has now in possession, to him and his heirs or assigns
for ever. Item I give unto my Daughter Lucy Green one Negro Woman named
Sally with all her future Increase to her & her heirs or assigns for ever.

I am I send to my beloved Wife Dolly Green during her natural life
the use of all the residue of my Estate both real and personal
Item I give to my two sons to wit Hannon Jones Green & John Robert
Green after the death of my wife Dolly all my Lands with its appur-
tenances therunto belonging to be equally divided amongst them &
their Heirs or assigns for ever but in case my said son John should
die before he arrives of Lawful age or a Lawful he gotten. Heir of
his body that my son Hannon Jones Green shall hold and possess
in fee simple inheritance all the Lands that I shall die possessed
with & to remain to him & his heirs forever

to my four Children to wit John Robert Green, Lucy Green, Sally
Jordan Green & Elizabeth Green after the death of my wife Dolly
Green all that part of my Estate which I have lent to my wife
Dolly (Land Excepted) to be equally divided amongst them and to
remain to them and their Heirs or assigns forever

I constitute leave and appoint my Wife Dolly Green & friend
Stephen Jones my Executors to execute this my last Will and
Testament and I do by these presents make void all and every
