 manner Here following (Viz) Item I give bequeath unto my son
 William Satumer my land and Plantation whereon I now live after
 my wifes decease to him and his heirs for ever. Item I give
 and bequeath unto my son John Satumer Jun^r one Negro man named
 Sam and twenty pounds Cash after my wife decease to him and
 his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son George Satumer
 Two Negroes named Gabe and Avery and their Increase after my wife
 decease to him this heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son
 Robert Satumer one Negro boy named Jacob after my wife decease to
 him and his heirs forever. Item I give bequeath unto my daughter Betty
 Burason five pounds Cash after my wife decease to her three heirs forever.
 Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mourning Satumer
 Two Negroes named Swath and Junny with one feather bed & Furniture
 after my wife decease. And their Increase to her and her heirs forever.
 Item I give bequeath unto my Daughter Leah Satumer one Negro
 named Ned with one feather bed & Furniture, after my wife decease
 to her three heirs forever. Item I send unto my loving wife Betty Satumer
 my land and Plantations whereon I now live with the following negroes
 named Sam, Gabe, Avery, Swath Junny, Jacob and Ned with the Stock
 of all kinds during her life with the crop of Corn Tobacco Wheat Vents with
 the household White Iron Furniture and Plantation Utensils and after my
 wifes decease my will and desire is that the Stock of all kinds with the
 beds, Household and Kitchen furniture should be sold and the money after
 the same are paid to be divided equally between my three daughters.

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lastly I do recommend and appoint my two sons George Latimer Robert Latimer
my whole sole executors to this my last will and Testament Revoking and annulling
all wills hereto made by me. As things I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
This 24 day of July one thousand seven hundred twenty nine.

one hundred Dollars in Cash to be raised out of my estate as her part of
my Stock and furniture and lastly I give to my son Thomas the
whole of my estate that is not mentioned or already disposed of of every
kind whatsoever to him and his heirs forever and my desire is that
there shall be no apportionment of my estate and I do hereby appoint my
son Thomas executor of this my last will and Testament. I
