I William Gess of Brunswick County do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament (to wit) I give unto my Brother John Gess my half of the Tool Bridge a Cross Meherrin River I leave unto my beloved wife Pricilla Gess all my Estate both real & Personal during her natural life and I give unto my said wife all that part of my Estate which come by her in fee to dispose of as she may Please. My Will and further desire is that the whole of my Estate not hereby given be equally Divided amongst my Brothers & Sisters after the death of my said wife and in case any of my brother or sisters should die before my wife bearing issue my desire is that some of my Estate as would have fallen to my said Dece^d Brother or sister shall be equally Divided between such issue I do hereby publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament revoking all former Wills by me made As witness my hand & Seal this 13th day of July 1798
