In the name of God Amen I Joseph Baugh of the
County of Brunswick do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament in manner and form following. Item I give unto my son
Littleberry when he arrives at the age of Twenty one years one Negro Boy
named Jesse to him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my son
Jock when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years one Negro
Girl named Chantob to her and her heirs forever. Item I give unto my
Daughter Nancy when she arrives at the age of Eighteen or marries one
Negro Girl named Judy to her and her heirs forever. Item I give
unto my two sons Littleberry and Jock the tract of Land on which I now
live to be equally divided between them on the death of Dearly beloved wife
Siller. Item I lend unto my Dearly beloved wife during her life the Tract
of land given as above to my two sons. Item I lend unto my Dearly
beloved wife wife Siller during her life all the rest of my estate and at her
death it is my will and desire that it be equally divided among my then
surviving children. Item it is my will & desire that if either of my
children should loose the Negro I have given him before he shall get the
negro in possession that in that case my Executors shall make good the
loss of the 2^d Negro the said Child at the death of my wife Siller out of

the estate I have but my said wife. Hence it my will and desire that my executors do
sell the following Negroes Will and Child for the purpose of paying all my just debts last
I do nominate and appoint my Dearly beloved wife Siller Baugh Gray Edmunds and
Ophraia Jackson executors and Executors to this my last Will and Testament. In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day of November
One thousand Seven hundred and ninety six.

Branswick in the state of Virginia being in my right mind memory and senses do
make this my last Will and Testament. In witness first I give my Soul to Almighty
God who gave it me my Body I commit to the Earth from whence it came to be
therein buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named; and as for what
would Estate it hath pleased God to possess me with I give and dispose of as
follow (to wit). Item I give unto my son Kemmon Jones Green three Negroes named
Britt Harry and Sarah with all their future Increase also one feather Bed &
furniture one Iron Gray mare & filly of same colour nine head of hogs & three head
of cattle all of which he has now in possession, to him and his heirs or assigns
for ever. Item I give unto my Daughter Lucy Green one Negro Woman named
Sally with all her future Increase to her & her heirs or assigns for ever.
